

Landscape

During recent inspections, the association has noticed homes with lack of landscape maintenance. What am I responsible for as a single family home homeowner?:

- * Grass shall be maintained in a neat and appropriate manner and cannot exceed 5" high. This includes the right of way in front of your homes.
- * **Edging** of all streets, curbs, beds and borders shall be performed as needed. Chemical edging shall not be permitted.
- * All beds are to be weeded upon every cut. **Weeds** growing in joints in curbs, driveways, and expansion joints shall be removed as needed. Chemical treatment is permitted.
- * Street trees rings need to be mowed and maintained and must stay consistent with the original installation material, Cypress Brown mulch. Rocks, any other mulch material/color and light fixtures are not allowed.

Keeping the landscape on your home beautiful, not only helps the community look great but also helps with the value of your home.

Assessment Payment

Past due invoices are being circulated this week. To avoid late charges, payment must be received no later than Monday, May 9, 2022.

Annual Assessment

Quarter 2 payments were due on April 1, 2022. Payments made after April 10th will incur interest and late fees. Quarter 3 payment is due on July 1, 2022.

Dear Townhome Residents,

We have noticed several property landscapes throughout the community that have mild to severe mulch washouts in the plant beds. The RTCA is currently working with Paradise Lawns & Landscaping to correct all of the washouts found on townhome properties. Mulch

The RTCA townhome mulching is scheduled to commence in the fall after the rainy season. A notification and official date will be provided to the townhome community residents when the time approaches.

Pressure Washing

The association is planning a community pressure cleaning service for all the townhome sidewalks and common areas, to be conducted in the fall after the rainy season. If you would like to pressure wash your property or walkways prior to the community cleaning, you may feel free to do so.

Design Review Board Applications/Violations

Every resident that purchases a home within the Tohoqua community is a member of the Tohoqua Master Association, Inc. Each resident that purchases a townhome unit is a member of two associations. The Tohoqua Master Association, Inc. and The Residences at Tohoqua Community Association, Inc.

The Tohoqua Master Association, Inc has a Design Review Board that reviews and makes determinations on all exterior modifications within the Tohoqua Community.

Alterations and Additions

In the Master Declaration for Tohoqua, <u>Section 12.1</u> <u>Alterations and Additions</u> it states no material alteration, addition, or modification to a Lot or Home, or material change in the appearance thereof, shall be made without prior written approval thereof

being first had and obtained from the DRB as required by this Declaration.

When residents make any modification or add personal items to any portion of the exterior of their unit without having the required written approval from the DRB, they are in violation. Normal balcony or front porch furniture is an exception.

To be in compliance with your community documents please submit an application and obtain written approval from the DRB for, but not limited to, the following exterior modifications and additions:

Hoses & Holsters (Submit an application)

A retractable hose holder may be permitted but an application must be submitted and a written approval from the DRB is required prior to installation. (*Note. Retractable hose holder must match the exterior color scheme of the unit. Hoses should not be left unraveled on any portion of the property, when not in use.)

<u>Lighting / String Lights / Security Cameras</u> – (Submit an application)

The Design Review Board shall be responsible for determining in its sole discretion whether exterior lighting is an annoyance or unreasonably illuminates another Owner's property. Proposed replacement or additional fixtures must be compatible in style and scale with the applicants house. No exterior lighting or cameras will be directed outside of an Owner's property. Proposed additional lighting will not be approved if it will result in an adverse visual impact to adjoining neighbors due to location, wattage, or other features. Low-voltage or solar-powered landscape lighting shall be consistent with street lighting, including low voltage floodlighting, is permitted so long as all wiring is concealed from view, and light fixtures do not stand more than 18" above the ground. No more than 10 lights per Lot are permitted without prior written approval from the DRB. (Page 8 & 9, Design Review Manual) (*Note-All wiring must be concealed from view or be painted to match the exterior color scheme of the townhome unit.)

If you have installed any of the above items but have not submitted an application, please do so at the earliest convenience. A courtesy letter will be sent to all properties in violation as a reminder to submit a DRB application for items that require an approval.

Community Friendly Reminders

- **Community Ponds** The ponds in the community are retention ponds. No swimming, fishing or boating is allowed.
- Street Parking The Tohoqua Master Association kindly asks you to be courteous of your neighbors and park your cars in your garage or on your driveway. This applies for the residents and visitors.
- Trash Cans As stated in the Design Review Manual, "all trash containers must be stored in the rear yard or garage and out of view of the street on non-collection days. Garbage cans and trash containers shall not be placed outside the home for pick-up earlier than 7:00pm on the day preceding the pick-up and shall be removed the day of Please discontinue leaving the pick-up". trash receptacles in public view on noncollection days and follow the schedule as stated in the community declaration. Also, trash cans cannot be placed directly in the crosswalks, in the pedestrian path ways. As a friendly reminder, trash pickup days are:

Tuesdays: Trash (Brown)
Wednesdays: Yard (Green)
Fridays: Recycling (Blue)

Lock Box - In need to make an assessment or event payment or submit a DRB Application and can't make it to the onsite management office? For your convenience, a lock box was installed in the fitness center which opens daily from 4:30 am until 11:00 pm.



Community/Builder Dumpsters -

Residents may NOT use the community/builder dumpsters for their bulk trash. This includes any building materials from resident contractors.

Please be advised that this is considered illegal dumping and is punishable by law. Under Florida State Statute 403.413, it is illegal to dump, discard, place, throw, dispose, or deposit any rubbish, waste, or trash onto any property (private or public) without consent. Fines associated with Felony Littering can cost an offender anywhere between \$100 - \$500.
